When indicated, counseling will be combined with other treatment supports such as case management, medication(s), and supportive employment services. We engage in brief, solution focused interventions that seek to achieve shared treatment goals in the shortest amount of time possible.

Achieving positive treatment outcomes may involve the temporary or long term use of medication therapy. This is determined by a thorough evaluation by our psychiatric staff. When medication is part of the overall treatment plan, ongoing medication management services are provided to monitor medication effectiveness and side effects.
