TECHNIQUES UTILIZED

Conscious Discipline

The therapist will work with the child and family to teach Early Childhood Conscious Discipline Techniques with a focus on connection, attunement, and overall emotional regulation.

Neurosequential Model

The therapist will provide psychoeducation on the effects of early child interactions on the brain, and the effects of trauma on future intimacy and attachment.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

Weekly in-home therapy sessions. Solution focused meetings targeted to your child and family's treatment target. Treatment targets tailored to improving parent-child connection, whole family regulation, and decreasing both child and family distress.
