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

VOCATIONAL CASE MANAGEMENT CAREER COUNSELING

Receiving financial support from the Butler, Warren, Clinton County Community Mental Health Boards, WorkPlace Associates Vocational Case Management educates, coordinates, and advocates for job seekers with mental health issues.

This program typically centers around a personalized "Action Plan" designed to help the job seeker learn about themselves, set goals, and create incremental steps to attain their employment goal. Additionally, Vocational Case Managers refer participants to outside services, such as Therapeutic Counseling, Benefits Analysis or Bureau of Vocational Rehabilitation (BVR) through Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (ODD.)

EDUCATIONAL/TRANSITIONING YOUTH SERVICES

Butler County Community Mental Health Board Funded programs are also active in local High Schools. In addition services are provided at the Juvenile Detention Center (JDC). In these locations, WorkPlace Associates Educational Specialists provide career interest testing, job seeking skills training, social skills instruction, and mental health education.

SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT

OOD/BVR provides funding for Supported Employment. Supported Employment services include Career Assessment, Job Try-Outs, Individualized Job Placement, Job Coaching (at or away from the work site), and Job Retention Services. Approximately 100 individuals access these services annually.

THE COMMUNITY LINKAGE PROGRAM

Operated by the Office of Forensic Services (OFS) of the Ohio Department of Mental Health (ODMH). This program operates in accordance with the guiding principles and identified priorities of ODMH. ODMH developed the program in coordination with the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (ODRC) as a response to an identified need.

The primary purpose of the (Voluntary) Community Linkage Program is the improvement of continuity of mental health care for offenders entering and leaving the prison system.

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES PROVIDED

Case consultation and crisis intervention services for adults, children and families include:

- Job Readiness and Skill Training
- Resume Building
- Assistance with Job Applications
- Preparing for Interviews
- Community Based Assessments
- On or Off Site Job Coaching
